Rowan Medicine House Calls brings your health care provider to your home. We know that going to see patients where they live – in their own home – is good medicine. Our health care team will provide comprehensive, continuing care all in the comfort of the patient's home. During the home visit, our physicians and nurse practitioners provide personalized attention to the patient, which is particularly important for patients with chronic illnesses or other health problems, as well as those who have experienced a recent hospitalization.



How do House Calls differ from office visits?

House calls allow us to get to know our patients, their home, their families and caregivers. We interact with home health nurses and other therapists involved in the patient's care when necessary.

House calls do take more time for the health care team. During the home visit, the physician or nurse practitioner can give more personalized attention to the patient. This is particularly important if the patient is discharged from a hospital or nursing home and can benefit from the close follow-up care provided by the House Calls team. Often, this individualized care can prevent re-hospitalization soon after discharge.

Services

The House Calls health care team provides ongoing primary care and follow-up visits to homebound patients. Services include:

- In-home full medical evaluation
- Evaluation of daily function
- Mental status evaluation
- Routine laboratory tests
- Evaluation of the home environment for safety
- Discussion of living arrangements, family support, community services, and how to access emergency services, if needed

Do I qualify?

You can qualify for House Calls if you cannot leave home without considerable taxing effort. Some examples include:

- You require the aid of supportive devices such as a cane, walker, wheelchair, etc.
- You require the use of special transportation
- You need the assistance of another person
- You have a condition where leaving home may not be medically advised

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
