The study will take place at the **NeuroMusculoskeletal Institute** at Rowan University School of Osteopathic Medicine, 42 E Laurel Road, Stratford, NJ.

Researchers at the Rowan University School of Osteopathic Medicine are seeking volunteers to participate in a new study to help combat the opioid epidemic. The purpose of this study is to better understand if patients with opioid use disorder can effectively learn how to administer the overdose reversal drug, naloxone.

Researchers are studying if patients trained on naloxone use can effectively train peers in their network. All tests will be conducted at the NeuroMusculoskeletal Institute at Rowan Medicine in Stratford, New Jersey.
